AMIGA SOFTWARE SET FOR PRE-CHRISTMAS AVAILABILITY AND INTRODUCTIONS AT WORLD OF COMMODORE III

Toronto -- Commodore Business Machines Limited announced today that Version 1.1 of the Amiga operating system has been released and will be shipped to Canadian dealers this week. "The thousands of Amigas already shipped will receive no-charge upgrades from their dealers in the next few weeks," said Robert Graham, Vice President, Marketing. "Third party software developers have been waiting for 1.1 to release their products and are expected to start shipping Amiga software immediately."

Several Amiga software developers used the World of Commodore III in Mississauga last week, to launch their new products.

"Anakin Research, Electronics Arts, EMJ Datasystems (Tecmar), Aegis
Development, Maxicorp and Cherry Lane Technologies are expected to
have over 15 Amiga software and hardware products on display," said
Graham.

From game to drawing packages, to music software, to integrated spreadsheet, word processor, charting and communications programs, as well as RAM expansion cards, 20 MB hard drives, tape back-up units and 2400 Baud modems, the first wave of Amiga third-party support products will be in stores for Christmas, he said.

World of Commodore III had 60 exhibitors and about 45,000 visitors, making it the most heavily attended computer show in Canada.
