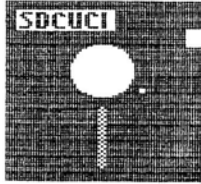
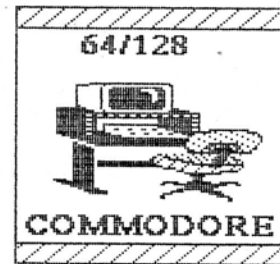

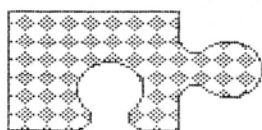
The beauty of this idea is that you would only need to bring in your computer once or twice a year. Which is not a lot to ask.

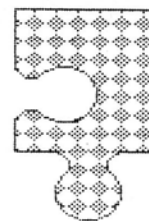
