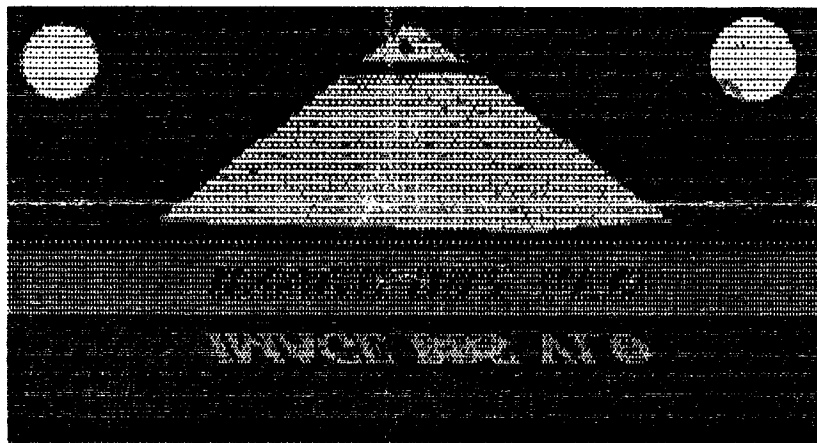


NISSA News

NISSA NEWS

In an attempt to get the NISSA sysops more involved with the support of New Image we are sending out this flyer and the accompanying disk.

In the next couple of weeks New Image will be sending out a newsletter to all IMAGE sysops announcing a third pfile disk that will include some of the version 1.1 enhancements that have been developed since the release of IMAGE. These enhancements will include



Joined/Unjoined message bases, Post/Next/Quit in the subboards, Credit for post/response, an improved +EM with full-verify/edit and selective delete/message store options, an enhanced editor with keyboard colors, improved message read routine, key files for Lt Kernel owners for the alpha file, and, of course, the pfiles on the disk. The pfile disk will sell for \$16.00 as usual.

We also have exciting news from Quantum link where we now have OUR OWN MESSAGE BASE, and we will be hosting the

Telecom Conference the end of this month. The date for the conference is January 31, 1989 and we would like all NISSA boards to help us make a success of it by posting a news file reminding all of your Qlink users about it. Also, any of you that are on Qlink are invited to join us and to adopt an appropriate NISSA handle as many of the NISSA members have done already. You could even use NISSAE0??? with the ??? being the digits of your IMAGE serial number if you wanted.

We have also heard that we will be helping out in the Telecom Help room on a regular schedule. There will be an IMAGE handle, either Don, Jay, John, Doc, Ray or Fred, in the

"Telecom Help Room" every Friday evening from 9:00PM ET to 11:00PM ET. During the rest of the week we will be there under our "regular" handles on this schedule: Sunday, Fred S, Tuesday, Ctuna, Thursday, Doc-Shade, and Saturday, Jay Levitt. Remember, we are counting on YOU to provide a large measure of local support to sysops in your area. We want you to be able to provide as much assistance as possible since that is what NISSA is all about. If you cannot provide support then you should not be a NISSA board.

We have also noticed that there are several NISSA boards that have not yet sent in a registration card. We feel that a SUPPORT-BOARD should be a REGISTERED board and ask that those of you that have not yet sent in your cards do so immediately. If you have lost your card just send in a note with your name, address, both voice and bbs phone numbers, your board name and serial number to us and we'll add you to the registered list. Any NISSA board that is not a registered board will be removed from the NISSA roles.

Also note that Lyon's Den West is now up and running on a 24 hour basis at 801-465@4560 and we ask that you post an opening newsfile about this for your local sysops that may need to call us for help. If they cannot get through to Port Commodore they can try Lyon's Den West. There is also an additional voice tech support line where Don can be reached during the evenings and off hours, 801@465@2956, you can help us post this as well.

The enclosed disk contains the four files "++0", "++1", "+.UD" and "+.UK" that should cure about all of the file transfer problems. We have also included a very short file that can be placed in your UD section that will allow others to check the dates on the proto files they are running, the file is "checkpro-

to" (we're not noted for originality when it comes to filenames). One additional file that has been included for your own enjoyment is a short Demo file created by Roy Kelm. This file will be enhanced and placed on the pfile disk and will be available for distribution, please do not distribute the one on this disk.

The "+files" that have been included on the disk are for immediate distribution, please add them to your UD sections if you have the room, and make them available to all IMAGE sysops.
